

STATEMENT FROM THE JUDICIAL AND LEGAL SERVICE COMMISSION RE. APPOINTMENT OF REGISTRAR OF THE SUPREME COURT 30 August, 2021

The current holder of the substantive post of Registrar of the Supreme Court, Mrs. Camille Darville-Gomez, will demit office upon being sworn in as a Justice of the Supreme Court.

Therefore, the Judicial and Legal Service Commission has advised His Excellency the Governor-General to appoint Mrs. Constance Delancy as the Registrar of the Supreme Court effective as of 9 September, 2021.

In addition to her appointment as the Registrar of the Supreme Court, Mrs. Delancy will continue to hold the designation and discharge the duties of Senior Court Administrator.
