DECISION

DARVILLE GOMEZ, J

- 1. The First Defendant applied by Summons filed on February 18, 2022 for legal costs. It was supported by an Affidavit of the First Defendant filed on March 21, 2022 and April 5, 2022.
- 2. The Court ordered that a retainer of \$100,000 and the First Defendant's legal fees incurred be paid out of the Trust Fund to Golden Gates Legal. However, there was an objection by the Second and Third Defendants to the payment of legal fees prior to the execution of the Retainer Agreement dated January 11, 2022. The Court adjourned to consider the issue.
- 3. The First Defendant relied upon the case of Petrona Russell and another v Anthony Thompson and another [2021] 1 BHS J. No. 1 as authority for an implied retainer. If

the Court accepted the existence of the implied retainer it would permit the First Defendant to claim the legal fees incurred prior to the execution of the written Retainer Agreement.

- 4. However, the court found that the <u>Petrona Russell</u> case was distinguishable because there was no written Retainer Agreement at all and the court had to examine the behaviour of the parties to determine whether there was an implied retainer.
- 5. In the instant case, the First Defendant was represented by Murrio Ducille at the hearings on November 2, 2021 and December 6, 2021. However, at the adjourned date on January 25, 2022 the First Defendant had changed counsel to Golden Gates Legal.
- Therefore, I do not accept that the fees incurred prior to the execution of the Retainer Agreement are recoverable from the Trust Fund and the First Defendant and I order that they be excluded.
