NOTICE

The Judiciary takes the security and wellbeing of all court users seriously and is therefore introducing measures to enforce best practices.

Effective 8th August 2023 all persons, inclusive of Attorneys, upon arrival to the Supreme Court and Magistrate Courts' buildings are required to register and present identification to the security officers.

The visitors' identification shall be held by the security officers and all persons shall receive a badge that must be worn visibly at all times. This badge allows access to the Public Areas of the Courts.

After receiving a badge you will be passing through a security screening, which includes a metal detector. You will then be allowed into the building, staff at the information desk in the main lobby will welcome you and guide you throughout your visit.

Persons are required to surrender the badge to the security officers when exiting the building whereupon the visitor's identification shall be returned.
